

# Bugs On A Stick

## Palette

Delta Ceramcoat, Bright Yellow, Black, Pink, White

## Brushes

Lowell Cornell, shader #10, #4, liner, deer foot

## Supplies

Kabob sticks

Drill

Wire

Straw hats or flowers

Ribbon

Hot glue/gun

Toothpicks

Spray sealer

## Surface

2- 1 1/2" Wood balls

## Preparation

Drill holes in wood balls the size of a toothpick, insert tooth pick and glue balls together

Drill 2 holes in top of ball for wire antenna's, glue in wire and bend around paint brush handle

Drill one hole in bottom to fit kabob stick and glue in

Bend wire to make wings, you can also make a little stinger for back side if you wish, but you will need to drill a hole to insert wire

## Painting Instructions

Using shader # 10 base bee Bright Yellow, when dry use shader # 4 and paint stripes Black

Using deer foot brush, dry brush Pink on cheeks

With end of brush dot Black for eyes and when dry use liner brush to add tiny white iris dots

Paint mouth Black with liner

## Finishing

Tie ribbon in bow around neck, glue on wings, glue on hat or flower on top of head

If your going to put them outside a quick coat of spray sealer will keep them looking nice longer
